## Calendula Flower Moisturizer 🌻

Sharing a little magic with the calendula flower we planted in the garden this year? Our recipe is simple, natural, and packed with skin-loving goodness:

- 1 cup of our garden-grown calendula flowers
- 1 cup of nourishing oil (olive, almond, or jojoba—something for every skin type!)
- A touch of beeswax and shea butter for that creamy, spreadable texture
- Optional essential oil for a soothing scent!

The Process:

1- Dry the calendula flowers

2- Add calendula flowers to a jar, cover with oil, seal, and let sit for 2-4 weeks. Shake occasionally, then strain.

3- Melt & Mix: Gently heat the infused oil with organic coconut oil

4- Cool & Store: Pour into a clean jar, cool, and store in a cool spot for up to 6 months.

Every participant will receive their own little jar of this handmade, garden-inspired goodness to take home!
